Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry in conjunction with NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital is seeking to recruit a full-time Psychiatrist for an outpatient attending position in the **Adult Partial Hospital Program** at NYP/Weill Cornell Medical Center, located on the Upper East Side of Manhattan. Responsibilities include leading a multi-disciplinary team to provide clinical care to adult patients with acute psychiatric illness to avert or shorten inpatient hospitalizations. The role includes supervision, training, and evaluation of medical students, residents, and other trainees.

**Minimum Requirements:** Board-certified or -eligible in Psychiatry. Candidates must possess or be eligible for a NYS license. Academically oriented physicians with experience in teaching and treating high risk populations are encouraged to apply.
