Position: Psychiatrist in Division of Emergency Psychiatry

Position Description: Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry, in collaboration with NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital, is seeking a qualified Psychiatrist for a faculty position within the Comprehensive Psychiatric Emergency Program (CPEP) at NYP/Weill Cornell Medical Center.

The successful candidate will provide medical leadership to a multidisciplinary team in the evaluation, acute management, and disposition of psychiatric patients requiring emergency services. Responsibilities also include participation in division, faculty, and other departmental meetings.

The schedule consists of twelve 12-hour shifts per month, which include shared coverage of nights, weekends, and holidays. A night-shifts-only schedule is also available for candidates who prefer it.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Board eligible or certified in Psychiatry
- New York State medical license
- Excellent organizational, communication and teamwork skills. Interest in teaching and working with trainees from multiple disciplines.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience and interest in quality improvement and data-driven performance metrics.
- Multilingual proficiency

Minimum/Maximum Compensation: \$309,000 per annum.
