

Seeking Inpatient Psychiatrist for Women's Mental Health Service:

New York Presbyterian Westchester Behavioral Health

Weill Cornell Medicine's <u>Department of Psychiatry</u> in collaboration with NewYork-Presbyterian is seeking a **Psychiatrist** for an Inpatient Attending position on its newly designed **Women's Mental Health Service** at Westchester Behavioral Health (WBH). Located on a historic campus in White Plains, New York, WBH is a 250-bed hospital with general and specialty programs across the continuum of care. Academically oriented clinicians with a strong foundation in reproductive psychiatry are encouraged to apply. The Service will be designed to address the needs of women requiring psychiatric hospitalization with illness onset in the peri- or post-partum periods; women experiencing psychiatric symptoms related to complex trauma; and women who would otherwise benefit from a specialized, trauma-informed approach to care at any point in the reproductive life cycle. Responsibilities include collaborating with a multidisciplinary team to provide world-class clinical care to patients and their families and teaching and training the next generation of clinicians.
