Position: Inpatient Psychiatrist

Location: NewYork-Presbyterian Westchester Behavioral Health, White Plains, New York

Summary: Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry is seeking a board-certified or board-eligible psychiatrist to serve as Unit Chief for the Inpatient Women's Mental Health Service at Westchester Behavioral Health (WBH). Located on a historic campus in White Plains, New York, WBH is a 235-bed hospital offering a full continuum of general and specialty psychiatric services.

This academically oriented position is ideal for a clinician with a strong foundation in reproductive psychiatry and a passion for trauma-informed care. The Women's Mental Health Service is designed to support women requiring psychiatric hospitalization during reproductive transitions, those experiencing psychiatric symptoms related to complex trauma, and others who would benefit from specialized, gender-sensitive care across the reproductive life cycle.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide clinical and administrative leadership to the inpatient unit.
- Foster a culture of excellence in patient care, education, and collaboration.
- Supervise and mentor junior faculty and clinical staff.
- Lead daily interdisciplinary team meetings and oversee clinical programming.
- Collaborate with a multidisciplinary team to deliver exceptional care to patients and families.
- Contribute to the teaching and training of medical students, residents, and fellows.

Minimum Requirements: Candidates must be Board certified or eligible in Psychiatry. Board certification/eligibility in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry preferred. Must possess or be eligible for a New York State license. Academic rank commensurate with experience.
