Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry is seeking a **Psychiatrist** for an Inpatient Attending position on its Young Adult Service at Westchester Behavioral Health (WBH). Located on a historic campus in White Plains, New York, WBH is a 250-bed hospital with general and specialty programs across the continuum of care.

Academically-oriented clinicians with a strong foundation in the evaluation and treatment of transitionalage youth are encouraged to apply. The Service will be designed to address the needs of young adults requiring psychiatric hospitalization. Psychiatrists will care for patients with a broad range of diagnostic presentations, including but not limited to personality disorders, first-episode mania and psychosis, depression, and anxiety disorders. Responsibilities include collaborating with a multidisciplinary team to provide world-class clinical care to patients and their families and teaching and training the next generation of clinicians. Psychiatrists with training in Child & Adolescent psychiatry, who have a strong foundation in DBT principles and the management of borderline personality disorder, and/or who have expertise in first-episode psychosis are particularly well-suited to this position.
