**Position Title:** Inpatient Psychiatrist for Orthodox Jewish Mental Health Service

**Location:** NewYork-Presbyterian Westchester Behavioral Health, White Plains, New York

Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry invites applications for a board-certified or board-eligible Adult Psychiatrist to join our Inpatient Orthodox Jewish Mental Health Service at NewYork-Presbyterian Westchester Behavioral Health (WBH).

This is an academically oriented clinician role ideal for individuals with a strong commitment to cultural psychiatry across the adult population spectrum. WBH is a 235-bed behavioral health hospital situated on a historic, park-like campus in White Plains. The unit functions as a general adult inpatient service, caring for patients with a range of psychiatric illness including psychotic, mood, and personality disorders. Between 50–80% of our 20 beds serve patients who identify as Orthodox Jewish, allowing for specialized, culturally informed care within a general psychiatry setting.

This unique program is dedicated to delivering the highest standard of inpatient psychiatric treatment while integrating cultural and religious identity into assessment, formulation, treatment planning, and discharge. Our team works closely with chaplains, families, and established community partners to provide care that is clinically excellent, culturally respectful, and stigma-reducing.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Provide high-quality, culturally attuned inpatient psychiatric care within a multidisciplinary team.
- Participate in daily interdisciplinary rounds and unit-based programming.
- Teach and supervise medical students, psychiatry residents, and psychology trainees as part of Weill Cornell Medicine's academic mission.
- Partner with Orthodox Jewish community liaisons, families, and chaplaincy to support individualized care and discharge planning.
- Contribute to a culture of clinical excellence, collaboration, and cultural competence in both patient care and education.

### Minimum Requirements:

- Board-certified or board-eligible in Psychiatry.
- Eligible for or currently holding a New York State medical license.
- Strong interest in inpatient care, cultural psychiatry, and/or working with diverse communities.

**Minimum/Maximum Annual Base Salary:** \$309,000
