



Partial Hospital Program Position at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center

Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry in conjunction with NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital is seeking to recruit a Psychiatrist for a full-time attending position in our adult Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center on Manhattan's Upper East Side. The PHP is a short term, intensive, ambulatory program that provides patients with either diversion or transition from inpatient care. Academically-oriented physicians with a strong foundation in the assessment and treatment of general psychiatric disorders are encouraged to apply. Responsibilities include working with a multidisciplinary team to provide diagnostic evaluation, clinical care, and psycho-education to patients and teaching and supervision of medical students and residents.

Minimum Requirements: Board certified or eligible in Psychiatry. Possess or be eligible for a NYS license. Minimum three years of experience working in a clinical setting.
