Partial Hospital Attending at NYP Westchester Behavioral Health Center

Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry in conjunction with NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital is seeking to recruit a full-time Psychiatrist for an outpatient attending position in the Adult Ambulatory Service at NYP Westchester Behavioral Health Center (WBHC) in White Plains, New York. Responsibilities include working with a multi-disciplinary team to provide clinical care to patients in the Partial Hospital program, consisting of a 12-slot General Adult Psychiatry Track. The role includes supervision and training of Cornell physician assistant students.

Minimum Requirements: Board certified or eligible in Psychiatry. Possess or be eligible for a NYS license. Established academically-oriented physicians with a strong clinical skills are encouraged to apply.
