Position Overview: The Department of Psychiatry at Weill Cornell Medicine is seeking a full-time Clinical Psychologist for a faculty appointment at the Center for Autism and the Developing Brain (CADB), located on the campus of NewYork-Presbyterian Westchester Behavioral Health. The successful candidate will work within a multidisciplinary team to conduct comprehensive psychological assessments. Additional responsibilities include research and supervisory duties.

Position Responsibilities:

- Conduct comprehensive diagnostic evaluations and psychological assessments for children and adolescents with suspected or confirmed Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- Supervise trainees, including psychology technicians, postdoctoral psychology fellows, and psychiatry residents
- Provide training on assessment tools and treatment approaches utilized at CADB
- May contribute to research studies as appropriate.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Doctoral degree (Ph.D. or Psy.D.) in Clinical Psychology from an APA-accredited program
- Licensed or license-eligible in New York State
- Demonstrated expertise in the assessment of Autism Spectrum Disorder, including administration of the ADOS-2
- Demonstrated expertise in administering neuropsychological assessments and academic testing measures, preferred
