Position Description: Weill Cornell Medicine's Department of Psychiatry is seeking a qualified **Psychiatrist** for a faculty position in the Telepsychiatry Program within the Division of Emergency Psychiatry. The Telepsychiatry Program delivers psychiatric consultation via telehealth for patients presenting to emergency departments or admitted to inpatient units across NewYork-Presbyterian and affiliated hospitals.

Responsibilities include:

- Providing psychiatric evaluation and management for patients in emergency and inpatient medical settings across four NYP hospital sites.
- Liaison communication with multidisciplinary teams on site to improve patient outcomes.
- Facilitating linkage to appropriate psychiatric and medical services

The schedule consists of sixteen 10-hour shifts per month, typically Monday through Thursday, with 1–2 weekend or holiday shifts included in the total. Some adjustments in shift schedule may be required in the event of staffing changes. Remote work is permitted in accordance with NYP's remote provider policy. Candidates must live within a two-hour commute of the main campus to ensure availability in person in case of technology-related disruptions to patient care.

- Board certification in Psychiatry
- New York State medical license
- Subspecialty training in Geriatrics, Addiction, or Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry
- Ease with technology adaptability including evolving telehealth platforms, ability to troubleshoot basic tech issues, and familiarity with secure messaging and navigation of the unified electronic health record across multiple hospital sites.
- Excellent organizational and triaging skills to navigate communications with multiple treatment teams, and strong clinical decision-making under time constraints

Preferred Qualifications:

- 2+ years of experience on an active inpatient consult service
- Telehealth experience
- Administrative leadership experience in acute settings, particularly triaging at a service level, resource allocation, staffing/scheduling, and collaboration with hospital leadership and multidisciplinary teams.
- Experience and interest in quality improvement and data-driven performance metrics.
- Multilingual proficiency

Minimum/Maximum Compensation: \$300,000 per annum.
